

## PRESS RELEASE

### 336<sup>th</sup> District Court Felony Dispositions for November, 2015

Richard Glaser, Criminal District Attorney, released a list of people who entered into plea agreements with his office during the November dockets before Judge Laurine Blake of the 336<sup>th</sup> District Court of Fannin County. The following individuals either entered guilty pleas and accepted responsibility for their conduct without further court action or their cases went to trial and a Fannin County Jury rendered the verdict and sentence indicated.

**Jason Garrett Amos, 21, of Bristol, Virginia** - pleaded guilty to *three (3)* 2nd Degree Felony offenses of **SEXUAL ASSAULT OF A CHILD**. Amos was convicted and sentenced to a term of 7 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$604 court costs in each case.

**Michael Ray Atchley, 32, of Dodd City** - pleaded not guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY**. Atchley was FOUND GUILTY BY A JURY and punishment was assessed by the Jury. Atchley was sentenced to the maximum applicable sentence of 10 years Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and in addition assessed a \$2,000 fine and \$394 court costs.

**Garrett Loron Bonham, 24, of Bonham** – pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF A BUILDING**. Bonham was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 4 years and assessed a \$750 fine and \$254 court costs.

**Ronnie Gene Bush, 52, of Windom** – pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* State Jail Felony offense of **POSS (Possession) CS (Controlled Substance) PG 1 (Penalty Group 1) <1G (Less Than 1 Gram)**. Bush was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed a \$1,500 fine, \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Tiffany Jones, 33, of Dallas** - pleaded guilty to the 2nd Degree Felony offense of **AGGRAVATED ASSAULT W/DEADLY WEAPON**. Jones was convicted and sentenced to a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Tiffany Jones, 33, of Dallas** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED/OPEN ALCOHOL CONTAINER 3RD/MORE**. Jones was convicted and sentenced to a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$100 restitution.

**James Samuel Kidd, 34, of Greenville** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **ASSAULT FAMILY/HOUSEHOLD MEMBER W/PREVIOUS CONVICTION – ENHANCED**. Kidd was convicted and sentenced to a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$314 court costs.

**James Samuel Kidd, 34, of Greenville** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY – ENHANCED**. Kidd was convicted and sentenced to a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$329 court costs.

**Ashley Martin, 28, of Dallas** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G**. Martin was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 4 years and assessed \$1,000 fine, \$304 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Sharon McRae, 50, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Adjudicating Guilt. McRae was convicted and sentenced to a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$244 court costs for the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **OBSTRUCTION OR RETALIATION** committed on or about February 16, 2011.

**Dustin Ray Reese, 23, of Honey Grove** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Adjudicating Guilt. Reese was convicted and sentenced to a term of 180 days incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$70 restitution for the State Jail Felony offense of **FORGERY OF A FINANCIAL INSTRUMENT** committed on or about April 4, 2010.

**Jerry Don Roskowske, 44, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DRUG FREE ZONE**. Roskowske was convicted and sentenced to a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$2,000 fine, \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution. After sentencing Roskowske, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 10 years.

**Jerry Don Roskowske, 44, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G**. Roskowske was convicted and sentenced to a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$374 court costs and \$180 restitution. After sentencing Roskowske, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 5 years.

**Sandra Smith, 28, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSSESSION CS PG 1 <1G**. Smith was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed a \$1,500 fine, \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Jerry Wayne Williams, 28, of Denison** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **SEX OFFENDERS DUTY TO REGISTER W/PREVIOUS CONVICTION – ENHANCED**. Williams was convicted and sentenced to a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$264 court costs.

**Jammie Jean Yeley, 32, of Whitewright** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Revoking Community Supervision. Yeley was convicted and sentenced to a term of 15 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$2,500 fine, \$374 court costs and \$140 restitution for the State Jail Felony offense of **POSSESSION CS PG 1 <1G** committed on or about August 3, 2012.
