## 336<sup>th</sup> District Court Felony Dispositions for December, 2015

Richard Glaser, Criminal District Attorney, released a list of people who entered into plea agreements with his office during this past December dockets before Judge Laurine Blake of the 336<sup>th</sup> District Court of Fannin County. The following individuals either entered guilty pleas and accepted responsibility for their conduct without further court action or their cases went to trial and a Fannin County Jury rendered the verdict and sentence indicated.

**April Asselin, 39, of Telephone** - pleaded guilty to the lesser included State Jail Felony offense of **POSS** (*Possession*) **CS** (*Controlled Substance*) **PG 1** (*Penalty Group 1*) **<1G** (*Less Than 1 Gram*). Asselin was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed a \$750 fine, \$379 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**April Asselin, 39, of Telephone** - pleaded guilty to the Third Degree Felony offense of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY**. Asselin was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed \$304 court costs.

**Richard Lynn Clark, 55, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the Second Degree Felony offense of **POSS CS PG** 1 >=4G<200G – ENHANCED. Clark was convicted and sentenced to a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$1,500 fine, \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Richard Lynn Clark, 55, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the Third Degree Felony offense of **DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED 3RD OR MORE – ENHANCED**. Clark was convicted and sentenced to a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$314 court costs.

**Stacie Leann Dotson-Davis, 31, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Revoking Community Supervision. Dotson-Davis was convicted and sentenced to a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$2,000 fine and \$304 court costs for the Third Degree Felony offense of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY** committed on or about September 17, 2014.

**Stacie Leann Dotson-Davis, 31, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Revoking Community Supervision. Dotson-Davis was convicted and sentenced to a term of 18 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$500 fine and \$319 court costs for the State Jail Felony offense of **THEFT OF PROPERTY <\$1,500 2/MRE PREVIOUS CONVICTIONS** committed on or about July 16, 2014.

**Teresa Anne Engle, 53, of Trenton** – pleaded guilty to the Third Degree Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1** <**1G DRUG FREE ZONE**. Engle was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 4 years and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Dylan Wayne Gee, 23, of Bonham -** pleaded guilty to the lesser included State Jail Felony offense of **ATTEMPTED INDECENCY WITH A CHILD EXPOSES**. Gee was convicted and sentenced to a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$739 court costs.

**Lloyd Mandrake Greene, Jr., 19, of Leonard** – pleaded guilty to the Third Degree Felony offense of **EVADING ARREST DETENTION W/VEHICLE**. Greene was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed a \$750 fine and \$304 court costs.

**Justin Cody Hicks, 45, of Bonham** - pleaded not guilty to the lesser included Class A Misdemeanor offense of **DEADLY CONDUCT**. Hicks was <u>FOUND GUILTY BY A JURY</u> and punishment was assessed by the Jury. Hicks was sentenced to 120 days County Jail and in addition assessed a \$2,000 fine and \$344 court costs.

Justin Cody Hicks, 45, of Bonham - pleaded not guilty to the Second Degree felony offense of AGGRAVATED ASSAULT WITH A DEADLY WEAPON. Hicks was <u>FOUND NOT GUILTY BY A JURY</u>.

**Leslie Holland, 50, of Bonham** – pleaded guilty to the Third Degree Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G DRUG FREE ZONE IAT**. Holland was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed \$379 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**James Edward Leftrick, 57, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the Third Degree Felony offense of **OBSTRUCTION OR RETALIATION**. Leftrick was convicted and sentenced to a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs. After sentencing Leftrick, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 5 years.

**Morgan Ann Lemon, 27, of Denison** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G.** Lemon was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 2 years and assessed \$309 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**David Dewayne Loftin, 41, of Pecan Gap** - pleaded guilty to the Second Degree Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF A HABITATION**. Loftin was convicted and sentenced to a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$249 court costs. After sentencing Loftin, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 8 years.

**Kenneth Howard Riley, 35, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the Second Degree Felony offense of **ABANDON ENDANGER CHILD IMMINENT DANGER BODILY INJURY**. Riley was convicted and sentenced to a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Kenneth Howard Riley, 35, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the Third Degree Felony offense of **EVADING ARREST DETENTION WITH VEHICLE**. Riley was convicted and sentenced to a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Tiffany Lea Riley, 31, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Revoking Community Supervision. Riley was convicted and sentenced to a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$306 court costs for the Second Degree Felony offense of MAN DEL CS PG 2 >=1G<4G committed on or about April 1, 2014.

**Tiffany Lea Riley, 31, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G**. Riley was convicted and sentenced to a term of 18 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Ashley M. Traver, 26, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Adjudicating Guilt. Traver was convicted and sentenced to a term of 9 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$255 court costs for the State Jail Felony offense of **ABANDON ENDANGER CHILD CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE** committed on or about December 12, 2009.
