

## PRESS RELEASE

### **336<sup>th</sup> District Court Felony Dispositions for February, 2016**

Richard Glaser, Criminal District Attorney, released a list of people who entered into plea agreements with his office during the February dockets before Judge Laurine Blake of the 336<sup>th</sup> District Court of Fannin County. The following individuals either entered guilty pleas and accepted responsibility for their conduct without further court action or their cases went to trial and a Fannin County Jury rendered the verdict and sentence indicated.

**Robert Delane Allen, 39, of Honey Grove** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* State Jail Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF A BUILDING**. ALLEN was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 3 years, assessed a \$500 fine and \$254 court costs.

**Terra June Bledsoe, 30, of Telephone** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **EXPLOITATION OF CHILD**. BLEDSOE was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years, assessed \$249 court costs and \$1,600 restitution.

**Terra June Bledsoe, 30, of Telephone** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **THEFT PROPERTY \$1,500 < \$20,000 ENH**. BLEDSOE was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed \$249 court costs.

**Donna Lee Bolf, 19, of Melissa** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF A BUILDING**. BLEDSOE was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years, assessed \$249 court costs, and a \$1,000 fine, which was probated.

**Donna Lee Bolf, 19, of Melissa** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF A BUILDING**. BLEDSOE was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed \$249 court costs.

**James Brandon Bond, 35, of Vidor** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* State Jail Felony offense of **CRIMINAL NEGLIGENT HOMICIDE**. Bond was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 18 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$319 court costs and a \$2,500 fine.

**Carlton Dwight Bridenthal, 30, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSS (POSSESSION) CS (CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE) PG (PENALTY GROUP) 1 <1G (LESS THAN ONE GRAM)**. Bridenthal was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 9 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Carl O'Neal Coffelt, Jr., 37, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G—ENHANCED**. Coffelt was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Carl O'Neal Coffelt, Jr., 37, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **EVADING ARREST DETENTION W/VEHICLE—ENHANCED**. Coffelt was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Kenderick Demon Cuba, 50, of Ladonia** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* Class A Misdemeanor offense of **ASSAULT CAUSES BODILY INJURY FAMILY MEMBER**. Cuba was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 180 days incarceration in the Fannin County Jail and assessed \$254 court costs and a \$500 fine.

**Derrick Shelby Davis, 24, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Davis was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 12 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$2,000 fine, \$324 court costs and \$230 restitution for the State Jail Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 3/4 <28G** committed on or about July 10, 2012.

**Derrick Shelby Davis, 24, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Revoke Community Supervision. Davis was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 12 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$249 court costs for the State Jail Felony offense of **THEFT OF MATERIAL ALUM/BRNZE/COPPER/BRASS <\$20,000** committed on or about February 17, 2013.

**Brandon Eugene Glass, 39, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* State Jail Felony offense of **ARSON OF BUILDING/HABITATION/VEHICLE RECKLESS CAUSE DAMAGE**. Glass was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years, assessed a \$750 fine and \$264 court costs.

**Meagan Michelle Harlan, 27, of Whitewright** - pleaded guilty to the Felony offense of **ACCIDENT INVOLVING INJURY**. Harlan was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years, assessed \$284 court costs and \$10,446.19 restitution.

**Meagan Michelle Harlan, 27, of Whitewright** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **ASSAULT PUBLIC SERVANT**. Harlan was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 10 years and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Meagan Michelle Harlan, 27, of Whitewright** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED W/CHILD UNDER 15 YOA**. Harlan was convicted and sentenced to a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division, assessed \$414 court costs and \$100 restitution. After sentencing Harlan, the court suspended her sentence and placed her on community supervision for a period of 5 years.

**James Megiuel Harvey, 19, of Greenville** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF A BUILDING**. Harvey was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed a \$1,500 fine and \$304 court costs.

**Ronnie Jay Hunnel, 46, of Dodd City** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DRUG FREE ZONE – ENHANCED**. Hunnel was convicted and sentenced to a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$379 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Ronnie Jay Hunnel, 46, of Dodd City** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **EVADING ARREST DETENTION W/VEHICLE – ENHANCED**. Hunnel was convicted and sentenced to a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs. **The Court ORDERED that the sentence in this conviction shall run consecutively and shall begin only when the judgment and sentence in the MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DRUG FREE ZONE -- ENHANCED case has ceased to operate. TEX. CODE CRIM. PROC. art. 42.01 § 1(19).**

**Ronnie Jay Hunnel, 46, of Dodd City** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY – ENHANCED**. Hunnel was convicted and sentenced to a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$304 court costs. **The Court ORDERED that the sentence in this conviction shall run consecutively and shall begin only when the judgment and sentence in the MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DRUG FREE ZONE -- ENHANCED case has ceased to operate. TEX. CODE CRIM. PROC. art. 42.01 § 1(19).**

**Ronnie Jay Hunnel, 46, of Dodd City** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **UNAUTHORIZED USE OF VEHICLE – ENHANCED**. Hunnel was convicted and sentenced to a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs. **The Court ORDERED that the sentence in this conviction shall run consecutively and shall begin only when the judgment and sentence in the MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DRUG FREE ZONE -- ENHANCED case has ceased to operate. TEX. CODE CRIM. PROC. art. 42.01 § 1(19).**

**Tamera Gail Magers, 50, of Trenton** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **EVADING ARREST DETENTION W/VEHICLE**. Magers was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 4 years, assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$269 court costs.

**Kavrin Rapheal Massey, 21, of Greenville** - pleaded guilty to the 2nd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 >=1G<4G**. Massey was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 10 years, assessed a \$2,000 fine, \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Kavrin Rapheal Massey, 21, of Greenville** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* Class A Misdemeanor offense of **UNLAWFUL CARRYING WEAPON**. Massey was convicted and sentenced to 67 days County Jail and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Justin Lee Mast, 34, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **ASSAULT FAMILY/HOUSEHOLD MEMBER W/PREVIOUS CONVICTION**. Mast was convicted and sentenced to a term of 3 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Justin Lee Mast, 34, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State’s Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Mast was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 1 year incarceration in the Fannin County Jail and assessed a \$2,000 fine and \$249 court costs for the *lesser included* Class A Misdemeanor offense of **ASSAULT CAUSES BODILY INJURY FAMILY MEMBER** committed on or about February 9, 2015.

**Wilbert Matlock, 36, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED 3RD OR MORE**. Matlock was convicted and sentenced to a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$379 court costs.

**Wilbert Matlock, 36, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY**. Matlock was convicted and sentenced to a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$304 court costs.

**Larry Darnell Mayberry, 50, of Denison** - pleaded guilty to the 1st Degree Felony offense of **AGG ASSAULT DATE/FAMILY/HOUSE W/WEAPON**. Mayberry was convicted and sentenced to a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$319 court costs.

**Larry Darnell Mayberry, 50, of Denison** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **ASSAULT FAM/HOUSE MEM IMPEDE BREATH/CIRCULATION**. Mayberry was convicted and sentenced to a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$319 court costs.

**Stacia Lee Miller, 41, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State’s Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Miller was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 7 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$1,500 fine and \$319 court costs for the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **ASSAULT ON A PUBLIC SERVANT** committed on or about May 8, 2014.

**Stacia Lee Miller, 41, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State’s Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Miller was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 7 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$319 court costs for the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY** committed on or about October 9, 2014.

**Jeremy David Morrison, 33, of Randolph** - pleaded guilty to the 2nd Degree Felony offense of **AGGRAVATED ASSAULT CAUSES SERIOUS BODILY INJURY**. Morrison was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years, assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$254 court costs.

**Kelvin Marcus Murphy, 54, of Wolfe City** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **THEFT OF PROPERTY >=\$1,500<\$20,000**. Murphy was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 12 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$319 court costs.

**Jimmy Ray Newman, 35, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to *two* 1st Degree Felony offenses of **AGGRAVATED ROBBERY**. Newman was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs in each case.

**Robert Jameson Perry, 31, of Sherman** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DRUG FREE ZONE – ENHANCED**. Perry was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$379 court costs.

**Robert Jameson Perry, 31, of Sherman** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY – ENHANCED**. Perry was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 3 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$304 court costs.

**Megan Pirie, 20, of Sachse** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **OBSTRUCTION OR RETALIATION**. Pirie was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 8 years, assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$254 court costs.

**Harold Lloyd Rose, III, 28, of Crystal City** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State’s Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Rose was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 12 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$1,000 fine, \$379 court costs and \$140 restitution for the State Jail Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G** committed on or about June 24, 2014.

**Kimberly Sparks, 47, of Ladonia** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **POSSESSION CS PG 1 >=1G<4G**. Sparks was convicted and sentenced to a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$2,500 fine, \$379 court costs and \$180 restitution. After sentencing Sparks, the court suspended her sentence and placed her on community supervision for a period of 10 years.

**Kimberly Sparks, 47, of Ladonia** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **THEFT OF PROPERTY >=\$1,500<\$20,000**. Sparks was convicted and sentenced to a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$314 court costs. After sentencing Sparks, the court suspended her sentence and placed her on community supervision for a period of 5 years.

**Kimberly Sparks, 47, of Ladonia** - pleaded guilty to *two* 3rd Degree Felony offenses of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY**. Sparks was convicted and sentenced to a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$304 court costs in each case. After sentencing Sparks, the court suspended her sentence and placed her on community supervision for a period of 10 years in each case.

**Glenn Ray Wolfe, 52, of Ladonia** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* Class B Misdemeanor offense of **POSSESSION MARIJUANA <2 OZ**. Wolfe was convicted and sentenced to 180 days County Jail and assessed a \$1,500 fine, \$304 court costs and \$180 restitution. After sentencing Wolfe, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 12 months.

**Larry Allen Zimmer, 36, of Leonard** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Zimmer was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$990 fine, \$314 court costs and \$80 restitution for the 2nd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 >=1G<4G** committed on or about March 16, 2011.
