

## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **336<sup>th</sup> District Court Felony Dispositions for December, 2016**

Richard Glaser, Criminal District Attorney, released a list of people who entered into plea agreements with his office during the December dockets before Judge Laurine Blake of the 336<sup>th</sup> District Court of Fannin County. The following individuals either entered guilty pleas and accepted responsibility for their conduct without further court action or their cases went to trial and a Fannin County Jury rendered the verdict and sentence indicated.

**David Allen, Jr., 53, of Honey Grove** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **MAN (MANUFACTURE) DEL (DELIVERY) CS (CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE) PG (PENALTY GROUP) 3/4 <28G (LESS THAN TWENTY-EIGHT GRAMS) DRUG FREE ZONE**. Allen was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$1,000 fine (probated), \$329 court costs and \$180 restitution. After sentencing Allen, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 8 years.

**David Allen, Jr., 53, of Honey Grove** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **POSSESSION MARIJUANA 4 OZ <5 LBS DRUG FREE ZONE**. Allen was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$329 court costs. After sentencing Allen, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 8 years.

**Tiffany Cynthia Arnold, 39, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **THEFT OF PROPERTY >=\$2,500<\$30,000**. Arnold was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 3 years and assessed a \$1,000 fine (probated) and \$304 court costs.

**Veronia Yvette Barba, 22, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to two State Jail Felony offenses of **ABANDON ENDANGER CHILD CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE**. Barba was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed a \$1,500 fine (probated) and \$573 court costs.

**Tyler Travon Bennett, 19, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **PROHIBITED SUBSTANCE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY-ALCOHOL/DRUG/PHONE/TOBACCO**. Bennett was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 2 years and assessed a \$1,500 fine (probated) and \$269 court costs.

**Michelle Nicole Brookins, 34, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Revoking Community Supervision. Brookins was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 15 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$3 court costs for the State Jail Felony offense of **ATTEMPT TO TAKE WEAPON FROM AN OFFICER** committed on or about October 13, 2013.

**Jason Burris, 32, of Ector** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Burris was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 15 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$2,000 fine, \$329 court costs and \$171 restitution for the State Jail Felony offense of **POSSESSION CS PG 3 <28G DRUG FREE ZONE** committed on or about December 18, 2014.

**Rupert Lee Cannon, Jr., 52, of Telephone** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* Class A Misdemeanor offense of **ASSAULT CAUSES BODILY INJURY FAMILY MEMBER**. Cannon was convicted and sentenced to a term of 1 year incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division,

assessed a \$750 fine and \$269 court costs. After sentencing Cannon, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 2 years.

**Wesley David Cherry, 58, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **EVADING ARREST DETENTION W/VEHICLE**. Cherry was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Wesley David Cherry, 58, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **ASSAULT PUBLIC SERVANT**. Cherry was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$369 court costs.

**Demarco Marquell Chriesman, 30, of McKinney** - pleaded guilty to the 2nd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 >-1G<4G**. Chriesman was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Demarco Marquell Chriesman, 30, of McKinney** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G**. Chriesman was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 18 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Demarco Marquell Chriesman, 30, of McKinney** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **ABANDON ENDANGER CHILD CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE**. Chriesman was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 18 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Gerald Miles Craven, 35, of Ravenna** – on June 10, 2016, defendant’s sentence was revoked to 7 years confinement in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and on December 9, 2016 shock probation was granted. Defendant placed on community supervision until August 25, 2021, and assessed a \$2,000 fine, \$374 court costs and \$140 restitution.

**Quentin Gregory Curtis, 52, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 1st Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 >=4G<200G**. Bryant was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 10 years and assessed \$324 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Derrick Shelby Davis, 25, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to three State Jail Felony offenses of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G—ENHANCED**. Davis was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 6 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division in each case and assessed a \$1,000 fine, \$942 court costs and \$540 restitution.

**John Dee Davis, 45, of Leonard** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State’s Motion Revoking Community Supervision. Davis was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 6 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$1,740 fine, \$314 court costs and \$140 restitution for the State Jail Felony offense of **POSSESSION CS PG 1 <1G ENHANCED** committed on or about March 11, 2013.

**John Dee Davis, 45, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G—ENHANCED**. Davis was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 6 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**William Gary Dykes, 41, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **THEFT OF PROPERTY >=\$2,500<\$30,000 ENH.** Dykes was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 3 years and assessed \$249 court costs and \$3,700 restitution.

**Reggie Jaquay Finney, 28, of Honey Grove** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Finney was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 3 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$2,000 fine, \$295 court costs, and \$140 restitution for the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DRUG FEE ZONE** committed on or about March 5, 2009. Shock probation was then granted. Finney was sentenced to 3 years confinement in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division probated for 5 years.

**Heaven Lee Hall, 28, of Bonham** - pleaded true to two allegations contained in the State's Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Hall was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 12 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division in each case and assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$528 court costs for the State Jail Felony offenses of **BURGLARY OF A BUILDING** committed on or about January 20, 2015.

**Heaven Lee Hall, 28, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to two State Jail Felony offenses of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G.** Hall was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 12 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division in each case and assessed \$628 court costs and \$360 restitution.

**Heaven Lee Hall, 28, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to two 3rd Degree Felony offenses of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DFZ.** Hall was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division in each case and assessed \$628 court costs and \$360 restitution. **The Court ORDERED that the sentences in these two convictions shall run consecutively and shall begin only when the judgment and sentence in the two BURGLARY OF A BUILDING cases have ceased to operate. TEX. CODE CRIM. PROC. art. 42.01 § 1(19).**

**Ricky Wayne Hendon, 49, of Honey Grove** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF BUILDING—ENHANCED.** Hendon was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$1,500 fine and \$254 court costs.

**Ricky Wayne Hendon, 49, of Honey Grove** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF VEHICLES W/PREVIOUS 2 OR MORE CONVICTIONS—ENHANCED.** Hendon was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Ricky Wayne Hendon, 49, of Honey Grove** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **EVADING ARREST DETENTION W/PREVIOUS CONVICTION—ENHANCED.** Hendon was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Danny Wayne Hicks, 45, of Honey Grove** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **ASSAULT FAMILY/HOUSE MEMBER IMPEDE BREATH/CIRCULATION.** Hicks was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 3 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$304 court costs.

**Tyler Lee Kilberg, 21, of Everman** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* 3rd Degree Felony offense of **INJURY OF A CHILD**. Kilberg was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$604 court costs.

**Tyler Lee Kilberg, 21, of Everman** - pleaded guilty to the 2nd Degree Felony offense of **AGGRAVATED ASSAULT W/DEADLY WEAPON**. Kilberg was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 15 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Shannon Renae King, 33, of Ladonia** – on July 11, 2016, the Ms. King pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 >=4G<200G DFZ** and sentenced to serve a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division. On December 12, 2016, shock probation was granted and Ms. King was placed on community supervision for 10 years assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Shannon Renae King, 33, of Ladonia** – on July 11, 2016, the Ms. King pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DFZ** and sentenced to serve a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division. On December 12, 2016, shock probation was granted and Ms. King was placed on community supervision for 10 years and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Jonathan Lynn Kitchens, 29, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **VIOLATION OF BOND/PROTECTIVE ORDER 2+ TIMES WITHIN 12 MONTHS**. Kitchens was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed a \$500 fine and \$249 court costs.

**Joseph Aaron Leach, 22, of Dallas** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Leach was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 12 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$2,000 fine and \$314 court costs for the State Jail Felony offense of **UNAUTHORIZED USE OF VEHICLE** committed on or about December 12, 2012.

**Zachery Wayne Lewis, 20, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSS MARIJ >4OZ<=5LBS**. Lewis was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$329 court costs.

**Brandy Michele Manley, 49, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **FRAUD USE/POSSESSION IDENTIFYING INFO # ITEMS <5**. Manley was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 3 years and assessed \$319 court costs and \$3,863.73 restitution.

**Jarold Glenn McPherson, Jr., 23, of Bogata** - pleaded guilty to the 2nd Degree Felony offense of **AGGRAVATED ASSAULT W/DEADLY WEAPON**. McPherson was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 8 years and assessed a \$2,500 fine and \$254 court costs.

**Jarold Glenn McPherson, Jr., 23, of Bogata** - pleaded guilty to two 3rd Degree Felony offenses of **DEADLY CONDUCT DISCHARGE FIREARM**. McPherson was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 8 years and assessed \$508 court costs.

**Clayton Allen Meeks, Jr., 37, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 2nd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 >=1G<4G**. Meeks was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 8 years and assessed a \$1,500 fine, \$374 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Clayton Allen Meeks, Jr., 37, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DFZ**. Meeks was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 8 years and assessed \$374 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**April Dawn Miller, 40, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DFZ**. Meeks was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed a \$1,500 fine, \$374 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Matthew Aaron Penna, 32, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSSESSION MARIJUANA >4OZ<=5LBS**. Penna was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 3 years and assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$314 court costs.

**Heath Wayne Phillips, 20, of Ladonia** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Phillips was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 30 days incarceration in the Fannin County Jail and assessed \$64 court costs for the *lesser included* Class B Misdemeanor offense of **POSSESSION CS PG 2-A <2 OZ** committed on or about January 10, 2014.

**William Cody Renfro, 24, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **POSSESSION CS PG 1 <1G DFZ—ENHANCED**. Renfro was convicted and sentenced to a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division, assessed a \$1,000 fine, \$329 court costs and \$180 restitution. After sentencing Renfro, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 8 years.

**Chad Westley Shrum, 36, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **INJURY CHILD/ELDERLY/DISABLE W/INTENT BODILY INJURY**. Shrum was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 8 years and assessed a \$1,500 fine and \$249 court costs.

**Eddie Lee Sinclair, 47, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G**. Sinclair was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 10 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Robert Thomas South, 37, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF A BUILDING**. South was convicted and sentenced to a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division, assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$269 court costs. After sentencing South, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 5 years.

**Jerry Pat Stewart, 26, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSSESSION CS PG 1 <1G**. Stewart was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed a \$1,000 fine (probated), \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Jerry Pat Stewart, 26, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSSESSION CS PG 2 <1G**. Stewart was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed \$314 court costs.

**Marcos Vasquez-Sandoval, 21, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to the 1st Degree Felony offense of **AGGRAVATED SEXUAL ASSAULT**. Vasquez-Sandoval was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$509 court costs.
