## 336<sup>th</sup> District Court Felony Dispositions for January, 2017

Richard Glaser, Criminal District Attorney, released a list of people who entered into plea agreements with his office during the January dockets before Judge Laurine Blake of the 336<sup>th</sup> District Court of Fannin County. The following individuals either entered guilty pleas and accepted responsibility for their conduct without further court action or their cases went to trial and a Fannin County Jury rendered the verdict and sentence indicated.

Scott Browning Allen, 33, of Windom - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Revoke Community Supervision. Allen was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 15 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — State Jail Division and assessed a \$840 fine, \$314 court costs and \$140 restitution for the State Jail Felony offense of POSS (POSSESSION) CS (CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE) PG (PENALTY GROUP 1 <1G (LESS THAN ONE GRAM) committed on or about February 14, 2013.

**Scott Browning Allen, 33, of Windom** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G**. Allen was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 15 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$364 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Davis Lewis Brock, 46, of Melissa** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **THEFT OF PROPERTY** >=\$30,000<\$150,000 - **ENHANCED**. Brock was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 12 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice - Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

Miguel Jose Cisneros, 20, Leonard - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of POSS CS PG 1 <1G Drug Free Zone. Cisneros was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 4 years, assessed a \$1,000 fine (probated), \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Eric Don Evans, 36, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1** >=1G<4G. Evans was convicted and sentenced to a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division, assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution. After sentencing Evans, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 6 years. Evans was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

**Gene Weldon Fogleman, 43, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **SEX OFFENDERS DUTY TO REGISTER LIFE/ANNUALLY**. Fogleman was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 3 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Christopher Lee Gilbert, 25, of Honey Grove** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* Class A Misdemeanor offense of **Attempted CREDIT CARD OR DEBIT CARD ABUSE.** Gilbert was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 50 days incarceration in the Fannin County Jail and assessed \$264 court.

**Anthony Ryan May, 24, of Bonham** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Revoke Community Supervision. May was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 1 year incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — State Jail Division and assessed \$374 court costs and \$180 restitution for the State Jail Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G** committed on or about March 5, 2016.

Anthony Ryan May, 24, of Bonham - pleaded true to *two* allegations contained in the State's Motion to Revoke Community Supervision. May was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division in each case and assessed a \$1,500 fine and \$678 court costs for the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF A HABITATION** committed on or about October 4, 2015, and February 1, 2016.

**David Shannon Moorman, 55, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G**. Moorman was convicted and sentenced to a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division, assessed a \$1,500 fine, \$329 court costs and \$180 restitution. After sentencing Moorman, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 4 years. Moorman was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

**Danna Rousseau Murdock, 50, of Princeton** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* State Jail Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G.** Murdock was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 6 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$379 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Pedro Noria, 30, of Trenton** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* 2nd Degree Felony offense of **INDECENCY W/CHILD SEXUAL CONTACT**. Noria was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

Christopher James Pennington, 32, of Bonham – pleaded not guilty to *two* 2nd Degree Felony Offenses of INDECENCY W/CHILD SEXUAL CONTACT. Pennington and was <u>FOUND GUILTY BY A JURY</u> and that same Jury rendered a sentence of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division in each case, and he was assessed a \$2,500 fine in each case and \$1,463 court costs.

**Thomas Randazzo, 33, of Dallas** – pleaded not guilty to the 1st Degree Felony Offense of **SEX ABUSE OF CHILD CONTINUOUS: VICTIM UNDER 14.** Randazzo and was <u>FOUND GUILTY BY A JURY</u> and that same Jury rendered a sentence of Life in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and he was assessed \$699 court costs.

**Thomas Randazzo, 33, of Dallas** – pleaded not guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony Offense of **INDECENCY WITH A CHILD EXPOSES**—**ENHANCED.** Randazzo and was <u>FOUND NOT GUILTY BY A JURY</u>.

Jason Lee Robison, 36, of Bonham - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Robison was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 18 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division for the State Jail Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G** committed on or about March 16, 2012.

**Jason Lee Robison, 36, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G**. Robison was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 18 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$324 court costs and \$180 restitution.

Jason Lee Robison, 36, of Bonham - pleaded guilty to the 1st Degree Felony offense of MAN DEL CS PG 1 >=1G<4G. Robison was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Susan Ray Thomas, 45, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* State Jail Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G.** Thomas was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years, assessed a \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution. Thomas was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

Michael John Watts, 45, of Bonham - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DFZ IAT - ENHANCED. Watts was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 10 years, assessed a \$2,000 fine, \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

Michael John Watts, 45, of Bonham - pleaded guilty to the 1st Degree Felony offense of MAN DEL CS PG 1 >=4G<200G - ENHANCED. Watts was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 10 years and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

Michael John Watts, 45, of Bonham - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of POSS DEL CS PG 1 <1G DFZ IAT - ENHANCED. Watts was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 10 years and assessed \$364 court costs.

Michael John Watts, 45, of Bonham - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of MAN DEL CS PG 1A <20 AU. Watts was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed \$314 court costs and restitution.

Michael John Watts, 45, of Bonham - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF FIREARM BY FELON - ENHANCED. Watts was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 10 years and assessed a \$254 court costs.

**Clint Dwayne Williams, 34, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **ASSAULT FAMILY/HOUSEHOLD MEMBER W/PREVIOUS CONVICTION** — **ENHANCED**. Williams was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division and assessed \$304 court costs.

**Glenn Ray Wolfe, 53, of Ladonia** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Wolfe was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 180 days incarceration in the Fannin County Jail and assessed \$264 court costs for the *lesser included* Class B offense of **POSS MARIJUANA <20Z** committed on or about July 22, 2014.

**Glenn Ray Wolfe, 53, of Ladonia** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF A BUILDING.** Wolfe was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 3 years and assessed a \$500 fine.
