336th District Court Felony Dispositions for July, 2017

Richard Glaser, Criminal District Attorney, released a list of people who entered into plea agreements with his office during the July dockets before Judge Laurine Blake of the 336th District Court of Fannin County. The following individuals either entered guilty pleas and accepted responsibility for their conduct without further court action or their cases went to trial and a Fannin County Jury rendered the verdict and sentence indicated.

Candida Renee Balderrama, 35, of Melissa - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **THEFT OF PROPERTY >=\$1,500<\$20,000**. Balderrama was convicted and sentenced to a term of 1 year incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division, assessed \$2,000 fine (*which was probated*), \$289 court costs and \$9,125 restitution. After sentencing Balderrama, the court suspended her sentence and placed her on community supervision for a period of 5 years.

Robert Henry Brock, 57, of Bonham - pleaded guilty to the 2nd Degree Felony offense of **DEL (DELIVERY) CS (CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE) MARIJ (MARIJUANA) TO MINOR**. Brock was convicted and sentenced to a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$379 court costs.

Robert Henry Brock, 57, of Bonham - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* State Jail Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G**. Brock was convicted and sentenced to a term of 15 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division, and assessed \$379 court costs and \$180 restitution.

Hunter S. Bua, 19, of Leonard - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 >=1G<4G**. Bua was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 8 years and assessed a \$1,000 fine, \$379 court costs and \$180 restitution. Bua was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

Marcus Shannon Ervin, 45, of Lawton, OK - pleaded guilty to the 1st Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 >=4G<200G**. Ervin was convicted and sentenced to a term of 6 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division, and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

Reggie Jaquay Finney, 29, of Bonham - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Revoking Community Supervision. Finney was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 3 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$2,000 fine, \$295 court costs and \$140 restitution for the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G DRUG FREE ZONE** committed on or about March 5, 2009.

Dylan Wayne Gee, 25, of Bonham - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **Attempted Sexual Assault**. Gee was convicted and sentenced to a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$679 court costs.

Matthew Harper, 28, of Dallas - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G DFZ IAT**. Harper was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed \$324 court costs and \$180 restitution.

David Lee Parks, 68, of Leonard - pleaded not guilty to the 1st Degree Offense of **AGGRAVATED SEXUAL ASSAULT CHILD**. Parks was ACQUITTED BY A JURY.

Ryan Mark Robertson, 27, of Denison - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G DFZ IAT**. Robertson was convicted and sentenced to a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division, assessed a \$1,500 fine, \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution. After sentencing Robertson, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 6 years.
