## PRESS RELEASE

## 336<sup>th</sup> District Court Felony Dispositions for June, 2017

Richard Glaser, Criminal District Attorney, released a list of people who entered into plea agreements with his office during the June dockets before Judge Laurine Blake of the 336<sup>th</sup> District Court of Fannin County. The following individuals either entered guilty pleas and accepted responsibility for their conduct without further court action or their cases went to trial and a Fannin County Jury rendered the verdict and sentence indicated.

**Shayla Michelle Askew, 26, of Honey Grove** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **CREDIT CARD OR DEBIT CARD ABUSE.** Askew was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed a \$1,000 fine (which was probated), \$369 court costs, and \$202.50 restitution.

**Shayla Michelle Askew, 26, of Honey Grove** - pleaded guilty to *two* State Jail Felony offenses of **ABANDON ENDANGER CHILD CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE.** Askew was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed \$638 court costs.

Candida Renee Balderrama, 45, of Melissa - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion to Adjudicate Guilt. Balderrama was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 1 year incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$2,000 fine, \$289 court costs and \$9,125 for the State Jail Felony of THEFT OF PROPERTY >=\$1,500<\$20,000 committed on or about July 26, 2011.

**Richard William Beatty, 41, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED 3RD OR MORE.** Beatty was convicted and sentenced to a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division, assessed a \$1,500 fine, \$329 court costs and \$100 restitution. After sentencing Beatty, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 7 years. Beatty was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

**Brian Keith Bell, 44, of Telephone** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED 3RD OR MORE.** Bell was convicted and sentenced to a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division, assessed a \$5,000 fine (which was probated) and \$329 court costs. After sentencing Bell, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 10 years. Bell was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

Jimmy Lee Brock, Jr., 31, of Bonham - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of CRIMINAL MISCHIEF >=\$2,500<\$30,000. Brock was convicted and sentenced to a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — State Jail Division and assessed \$269 court costs and \$8,273.05 restitution. After sentencing Brock, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 5 years. Beatty was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

**Kendra Dawn Chapman, 31, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED W/CHILD UNDER 15 YOA.** Chapman was convicted and sentenced to a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — State Jail Division and assessed a \$1,500 fine (which was probated) and \$329 court costs. After sentencing Chapman, the court

suspended her sentence and placed her on community supervision for a period of 4 years. Chapman was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

Mark Kenneth Ellsworth, 61, of Dallas - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED/OPEN ALCOHOL CONTAINTER 3RD/MORE. Ellsworth was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 8 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division and assessed \$314 court costs.

**Justen Andrew Frye, 33, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to *four* State Jail Felony offenses of **FRAUD USE/POSS IDENTIFYING INFO # ITEMS <5**. Frye was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division in each case and assessed \$1,216 court costs.

**Howard Wayne Gregory, 27, of Ravenna** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSS** (*POSSESSION*) **CS** (*CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE*) **PG** (*PENALTY GROUP*) **1** <**1G** (*LESS THAN ONE GRAM*). Gregory was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 4 years, assessed a \$1,000 fine (which was probated), \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution. Gregory was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

Majin Hernandez, 39, of Unknown - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of POSS CS PG 1 <1G. Hernandez was convicted and sentenced to a term of 12 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Austin Tyler Hinsley, 27, of Leonard** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* Class A Misdemeanor offense of **ASSAULT CAUSES BODILY INJURY**. Hinsley was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 2 years, assessed a \$1,000 fine and \$269 court costs.

Haley Holt, 23, of Gordenville - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Adjudicating Guilt. Holt was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division and assessed a \$1,000 fine, \$324 court costs and \$140 restitution for the *lesser included* 2nd Degree Felony offense of MAN DEL CS PG 1A >=20<80AU committed on or about November 3, 2013.

**Katrina Huschke, 45, of Bells** - pleaded guilty to the 2nd Degree Felony offense of **MAN DEL CS PG 1** >=1G<4G. Huschke was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Katrina Huschke, 45, of Bells -** pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY**. Huschke was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$254 court costs.

**Brandon Scott Jackson, 32, of Dalhart** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **DEADLY CONDUCT DISCHARGE FIREARM—ENHANCED**. Jackson was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 30 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division and assessed \$409 court costs.

**Justin Daniel Jarrell, 32, of Blue Ridge** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1** <**1G.** Jarrell was convicted and sentenced to a term of 15 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Patrick Leon Jones, 31, of Celeste** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY**. Jones was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division and assessed \$304 court costs. After sentencing Jones, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 5 years.

**Strittany Nicole Kersey, 25, of Bailey -** pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G DFZ IAT.** Kersey was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 10 years, assessed a \$1,000 fine (which was probated), \$369 court costs and \$180 restitution.

**Brittany Nicole Kersey, 25, of Bailey -** pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **ABANDON ENDANGER CHILD CRIMINAL NEGLIGENCE.** Kersey was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years and assessed \$424 court costs.

Jasmine Marie Lingelbach, 22, of Bonham - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Adjudicating Guilt. Lingelbach was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 9 months incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$1,000 fine, \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution for the State Jail Felony offense of MAN DEL CS PG 1 <1G committed on or about April 5, 2016.

James Harold Moon, 54, of Anna - pleaded not guilty to the 1st Degree Felony Offense of AGGRAVATED ASSAULT AGAINST A PUBLIC SERVANT. Moon was <u>FOUND GUILTY BY A JURY</u> and that same jury rendered a sentence of 25 years in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and he was assessed a \$10,000 fine and \$424 court costs.

Casey Wayne Norris, 34, of Honey Grove - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of SEX OFFENDERS DUTY TO REGISTER LIFE/ANNUALLY. Norris was convicted and sentenced to a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division and assessed a \$1,500 fine and \$314 court costs. After sentencing Norris, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 10 years.

**Jason Lee Owens, 37, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the *lesser included* State Jail Felony offense of **BURGLARY OF A BUILDING.** Owens was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 3 years, assessed a \$500 fine, \$254 court costs and \$1,030 restitution.

William Havens Rively, 69, of Telephone - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED 3RD OR MORE. Rively was convicted and sentenced to a term of 10 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division, assessed a \$1,500 fine, \$324 court costs and \$100 restitution. After sentencing Rively, the court suspended his sentence and placed him on community supervision for a period of 10 years. Rively was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

Jamie Elizabeth Shoemaker, 33, of Bonham - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of POSS CS PG 1 <1G. Shoemaker was convicted and sentenced to a term of 2 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed a \$750 fine, \$329 court costs and \$180 restitution. After sentencing Shoemaker, the court suspended her sentence and placed her on community supervision for a period of 4 years. Shoemaker was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

**Kimberly Sparks, 49, of Ladonia** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Revoking Community Supervision. Sparks was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed a \$2,500 fine, \$379 court costs and \$180 restitution for the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1** >=1G<4G committed on or about December 14, 2014.

**Kimberly Sparks, 49, of Ladonia** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in the State's Motion Revoking Community Supervision. Sparks was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 1 year incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$314 court costs for the State Jail Felony offense of **THEFT OF PROPERTY** >=\$1,500<\$20,000 committed on or about December 14, 2014.

**Kimberly Sparks, 49, of Ladonia** - pleaded true to the allegations contained in *two* State's Motion Revoking Community Supervision. Sparks was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 4 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – Institutional Division and assessed \$608 court costs for the 3rd Degree Felony offenses of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY** committed on or about July 1, 2015.

Michael Glenn Vanhooser, 29, of Ivanhoe - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of ASSAULT FAMILY/HOUSEHOLD MEMBER W/PREVIOUS CONVICTION—ENHANCED. Vanhooser was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division and assessed \$369 court costs.

**Michael Glenn Vanhooser, 29, of Ivanhoe** - pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **BAIL JUMPING AND FAIL TO APPEAR FELONY—ENHANCED**. Vanhooser was convicted and sentenced to serve a term of 5 years incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice — Institutional Division and assessed \$304 court costs.

**Vayne Lee Wilkerson, 60, of Bonham** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **POSS CS PG 1 <1G—ENHANCED.** Wilkerson was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 10 years, assessed a \$1,000 fine, \$314 court costs and \$180 restitution. Wilkerson was referred to the Fannin County Drug Court program of intense but personalized supervision.

**Dezarey Williamson, 22, of Savoy -** pleaded guilty to the 3rd Degree Felony offense of **ASSAULT AGAINST ELDERLY OR DISABLED INDIVIDUAL.** Williamson was placed on Deferred Adjudication Community Supervision for a period of 5 years, assessed a \$750 fine and \$269 court costs.

Casey Wayne Wilson, 29, of Paris - pleaded guilty to *four* State Jail Felony offenses of **CREDIT CARD OR DEBIT CARD ABUSE.** Wilson was convicted and sentenced to a term of 1 year incarceration in the Texas

Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division in each case and assessed \$1,266 court costs.

**Casey Wayne Wilson, 29, of Paris** - pleaded guilty to the State Jail Felony offense of **UNAUTHORIZED USE OF VEHICLE.** Wilson was convicted and sentenced to a term of 1 year incarceration in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice – State Jail Division and assessed \$304 court costs.
