Drugs Trafficking Operations and Aggravated Robbery Result in New Felony Charges

Criminal District Attorney Richard Glaser reports that on Thursday, May 24, 2018, the Grand Jury met to review evidence in twenty-one (21) cases presented for their consideration. The Grand Jury returned twenty (20) true bills or indictments. One (1) case was passed for further information. The Fannin County Grand Jury has returned 119 true bills of indictment so far in 2018.

It is important to note that an indictment is a formal charge and should not be considered as evidence of guilt and that all persons charged with a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
