







PROTECT YOUR CHILD FROM INTERNET CRIME

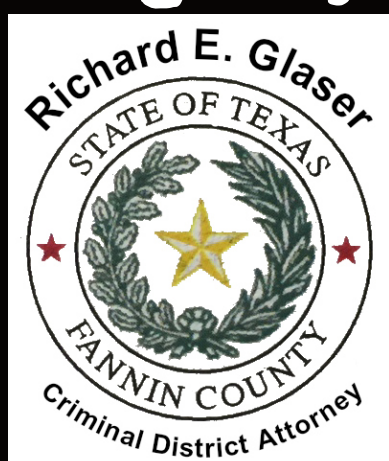
FOLLOW THESE CRIME PREVENTION TIPS FROM McGRUFF:

-  Instruct your child never to give out personal information online — such as her name, address, or school name — without your approval.
-  Teach your child about scams that appear as friendly emails or offers that are too good to be true.
-  Place your computer where you can see what your child is doing.
-  Install software that prevents access to inappropriate sites and chat rooms.
-  Teach your child what to do if he comes across inappropriate sites or receives emails or invitations from strangers.
-  Learn how your children are using the Internet by regularly checking frequented sites and monitoring how much time they spend online.
