

## PRESS RELEASE

### Special Meeting of the Fannin County Grand Jury

Criminal District Attorney Richard Glaser reports that at a special meeting called of the Grand Jury on Friday, November 1, 2019, they considered nine (9) cases presented for their review. All nine (9) cases were true billed or indicted. The Fannin County Grand Jury has returned 243 true bills of indictment so far in 2019.

It is important to note that an indictment is a formal charge and should not be considered as evidence of guilt and that all persons charged with a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
