Grand Jury Hears Multiple Drug and Assault Charges

Criminal District Attorney Richard Glaser reports that on Thursday, June 18, 2020, the current Grand Jury met in its final session and reviewed evidence in thirty-six (36) cases. This Grand Jury returned thirty-four (34) true bills or indictments listed below. One case was not billed and one was passed. The Fannin County Grand Jury has returned 203 true bills of indictment so far in 2020.

It is important to note that an indictment is a formal charge and should not be considered as evidence of guilt and that all persons charged with a crime are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.

The following people were indicted for the criminal offense and range of punishment indicated:

The Grand Jury also accepted the Annual Road Report from each of the Fannin County Commissioners. These road reports are a public record and also filed with the Commissioners Court each year. Section 251.005 of the Local Government Code provides *Commissioner's Road Report* –

(a) A county commissioner serving as a road supervisor shall make a sworn annual report during the ninth month of the county fiscal year on a form approved by the commissioners court showing:

- (1) The condition of each road or part of a road and of each culvert and bridge in the commissioner's precinct;
- (2) The amount of money reasonably necessary for maintenance of the roads in the precinct during the next county fiscal year;
- (3) The number of traffic control devices in the precinct defaced or torn down;
- (4) Any new road that should be opened in the precinct; and
- (5) Any bridges, culverts, or other improvements necessary to place the roads in the precinct in good condition, and the probable cost of the improvements.

(b) The report shall be entered in the minutes of the commissioners court to be considered in improving public roads and determining the amount of taxes imposed for public roads.

(c) The report shall be submitted, together with each contract made by the court since its last report for any work on any road, to the Grand Jury at the first term of the District Court occurring after the report is made to the commissioners court. Excerpts from those reports reflect the following:

Precinct 1 – Commissioner Gary Whitlock reports all roads are open to traffic at this time with the exception of two bridges that are closed: CR 1020 and CR 4130. His anticipated budget for road maintenance for the next fiscal year is approximately \$1,000,000.

Precinct 2 – Commissioner A J Self's anticipated budget for road maintenance for the next fiscal year is \$936,000 to maintain the roads at their present level. Bridges have been replaced on CR 5025, CR 5060, CR 4920 and CR 3810; bridge on CR 4255 is pending. New roads opened are CR 4833, CR 4922, CR 4923, and CR 4924.

Precinct 3 – Commissioner Jerry Magness reports all county roads in Precinct 3 are open. Anticipated budget for road maintenance for the next fiscal year is \$1,300,000. Budget will cover installation of culverts needed and road improvements due to lake construction traffic.

Precinct 4 – Commissioner Dean Lackey reports that a section of CR 2900 will be closed and relocated due to the new lake. Bridges on CR 2998 and CR 2900 are being replaced. Anticipated budget for road and culvert maintenance for the next fiscal year is \$710,000.

A new Grand Jury for the July-December, 2020, term will be impaneled and sworn in by Judge Laurine Blake of the 336th Judicial District Court on Wednesday, July 1, 2020.
